We are looking for dedicated individuals to deliver child abuse prevention programming for children in grades K-12.

Chaucie's Place provides child abuse and youth suicide prevention programming to schools and youth serving organizations. The child abuse prevention program is delivered in 45-minute to 1-hour sessions in a classroom setting. These presentations are scripted, however interaction with children is encouraged. Comprehensive training will be provided by Chaucie's Place.

Duties: Present body safety curriculum to children and youth in schools, primarily in Hamilton, Boone and Marion counties, but including Hancock, Hendricks, Madison, and Tipton counties as well. Interact with teachers, school staff, and children in a professional, but caring manner. All presentations are scheduled within normal school hours, generally 8am-3pm during the school year.

Qualifications: Bachelor's Degree in education, counseling, social work, psychology, or a related field preferred; or a combination of experience, education, and/or training. Presenters will be paid \$15/presentation on a contract basis.

Skills: Ability to work with and interact well with children, good presentation skills, effective communication skills with school representatives.
